

ATLA religion databases with ATLA Serials

This index is part of the EBSCO database collection. ATLA contains mostly citations with some full text; information is indexed from 1943 to the present.

ATLA database has capability to save individual search results, save links to searches, and create a search alert in the Keyword search option. You must create a free EBSCO account to take advantage of these features. A general electronic EBSCO database guide is found on the main library Database page.

Ask-a-Librarian Link

- links directly to Concordia's library reference e-mail

Help Link is available on the far right hand corner:

- use for help on individual pages or with a problem
- use to view citation style formats
- EBSCO tutorial link available
- Translate or change the language of the interface (also available in "tools")

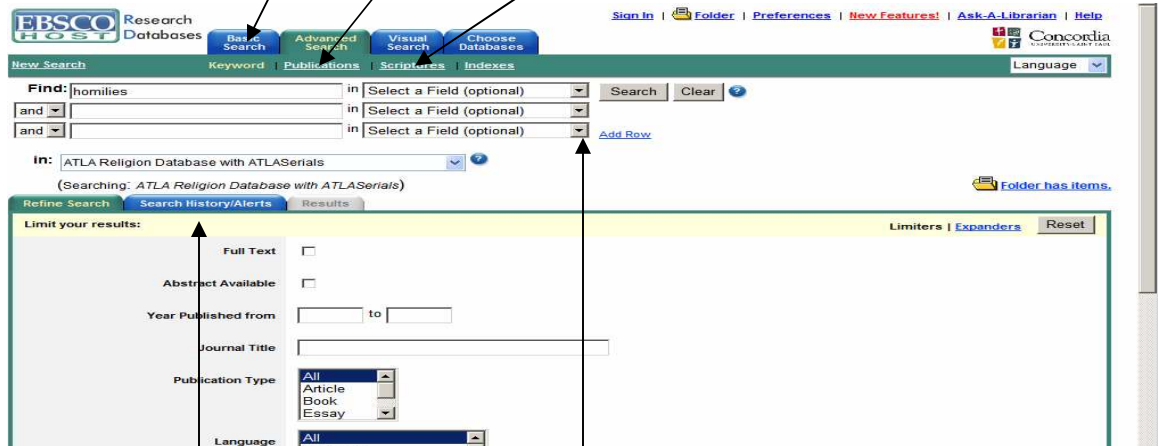
Article Linker: use to get full text with another database or interlibrary loan

Other searching techniques:

- combine terms using Boolean Operators (and, or not)
- truncate terms using an asterisk *
- Group terms using parenthesis ()

SEARCH TABS:

- use top tabs for *Keyword* (basic or advance) or *Visual* searches
- use toolbar to search for *Publications*, *Scripture*, or *Indexes*

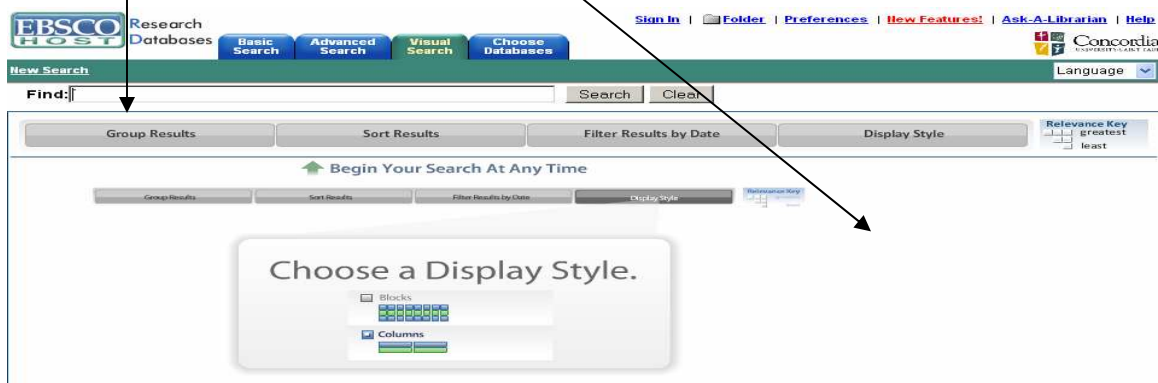


KEYWORD Searching:

- basic or advanced searches are available in the Keyword search.
- advanced search has various search options.
- Click on the down arrow to find choices (keyword is the default option, title, series, subject, *scripture citation*)
- advanced search also has expanders/limiters to focus search
- advanced search allows you to save searches & create web pages

VISUAL Searching:

- tutorial tour begins automatically when entering visual search
- Clusters results by subject or publication
- Articles found under clusters with ability to see full text or abstract
- Clusters usually include a "peer reviewed" option
- Navigation possible with Results map locator & arrows & zoom feature



PUBLICATIONS:

- browse alphabetically for journal or browse by entering title
- selecting a journal title gives publication information
- search within journal for indexed articles; narrow search by subjects which are located on left side of page; save search option
- journal alerts are not available in ATLA; use Academic Search Premier to set up a journal alert
