Many resources are available full-text online, but should you need something that is not available electronically, please remember that the library can help you obtain those materials also.

Links behind *Research Resources*

- *CLICnet*: Concordia's online catalog, which also indexes the collections of 14 libraries at Augsburg College, Bethel University, College of St. Catherine, Hamline University, Macalester College, Northwestern College, and the University of St. Thomas. This catalog is the 2nd largest catalog in the state of Minnesota. You do not need a username and password to explore this catalog, but you will need your name and 14-digit Concordia library barcode to *Request* materials.
- *Databases*: Generally, databases index and provide access to journal, magazine, and newspaper articles; there are many databases, both general and specialized. Some contain all full-text, some contain no full-text, some contain both. It is important that you select the best database(s) for your topic. You will see descriptions for the various databases on our *Databases* pages, The  icon indicates that a guide sheet is available in PDF form. You will also notice that there is a *Business/Management* link at the top of the page that will lead you to the most appropriate databases for your discipline.
- *Journal Finder (with Article Linker)*: When you find a reference to an interesting article in one database--but it is not available in full-text via that same database--*Journal Finder (with Article Linker)* can help. Using this tool, you may locate the full text in another database or fill out an interlibrary loan form so that you can request the article from another library.
- *Electronic Reference Shelf*: Provides links to a variety of reference tools. A most useful category is *Style/Citation Manuals – APA Citation*. Go here for help on using the APA Style Manual.
- *Forms/Requests*: This will lead you to interlibrary loan forms and a reference help link.
- *Supplementary Websites*: A small set of credible websites. Be sure to *customize* your home computer so that your *Google Scholar* searches will automatically show Concordia's database holdings. Customizing *Google Scholar* will make it possible to access full-text articles with one mouse click.
