



Viewing Results for Assessments in a Course or Context in eLumen

There are at least two ways to view results of any given Assessment: By selecting the course or by selecting the Assessment.

Viewing Results by Course

Click the **Courses & Orgs** tab; then **Courses & Context**. If you don't see the course you want, check the term drop-down box to be sure you've selected a **term** when the course was offered.


Above the course you choose, click the "Results" icon, .



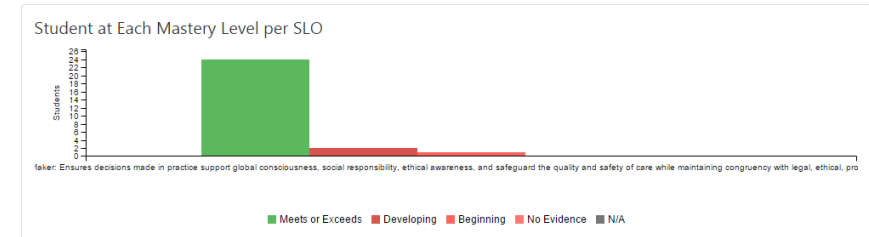
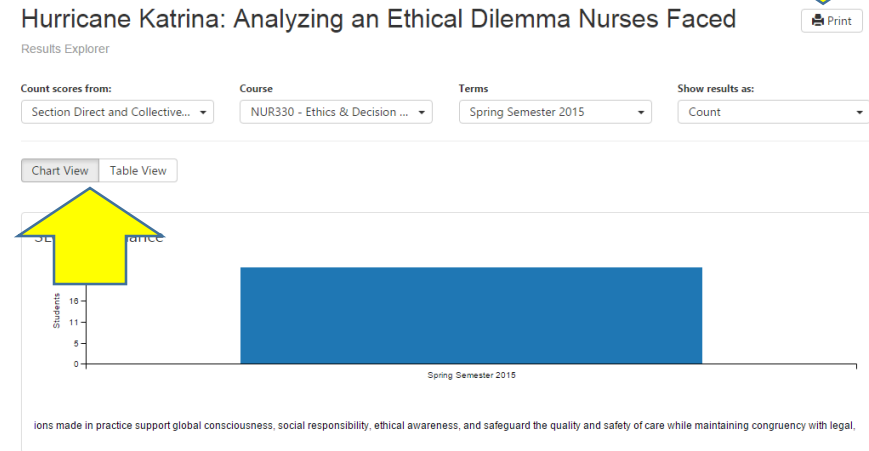
Now, click on the bar with the title of the Assessment with the results you want to view.

Viewing Results by Assessment

Click the **SLOs & Assessments** tab, then the **Assessments** tab. Make sure the **Assessment Results** tab is selected.

Then, sort for the SLO that you've assessed. If it's a Program Outcome, use the middle column to select the appropriate degree program (Outcome Class), then the appropriate Program Outcome or Outcomes. If it's a University Outcome or College or Student Development Outcome, use the right-hand column to select first the Outcome Class, then Outcome Category, then the specific Outcome(s). These selections will sort out those Assessments that have been set up and distributed for those outcomes.


