

CAEP Annual Reporting Measures
Outcome Measures – Ability of Completers to be hired in Education Positions for which they
have prepared

Concordia University Department of Teacher Education surveys our completers at the end of their first year after completion. The Transition to Teaching survey data provides us with feedback from completers related to their teaching status and beliefs about their preparation for the first year of teaching. Teacher Education completers were asked questions about their satisfaction of teaching effectiveness.

1. 87% of completers who responded to the survey reported they sought employment as a licensed teacher after completing their teacher education program.
2. 100% of completers who responded to the survey reported receiving a job offer for a teaching position.
3. 36% of completers who responded to the survey reported receiving two or more job offers.
4. 90% of completers who responded to the survey reported accepted a teaching position. Those positions are comprised by 62% in a public-school setting; 25% in a public charter school setting; 25% in a private school setting.
